The proposed 2020/21 biennial Budget for the National Oilheat Research Alliance



has been released for public comment. At the conclusion of the public comment period, the budget will be forwarded to the Department of Energy. Comments are due by September 1, 2019; anyone interested in reviewing/commenting should contact JHuber@NORAweb.org.

The 2020/2021 budget incorporates the 2014 and 2018 changes in the NORA statute, emphasizes research & development and adds an energy efficiency component. It also continues to emphasize close working relationships with state associations.
